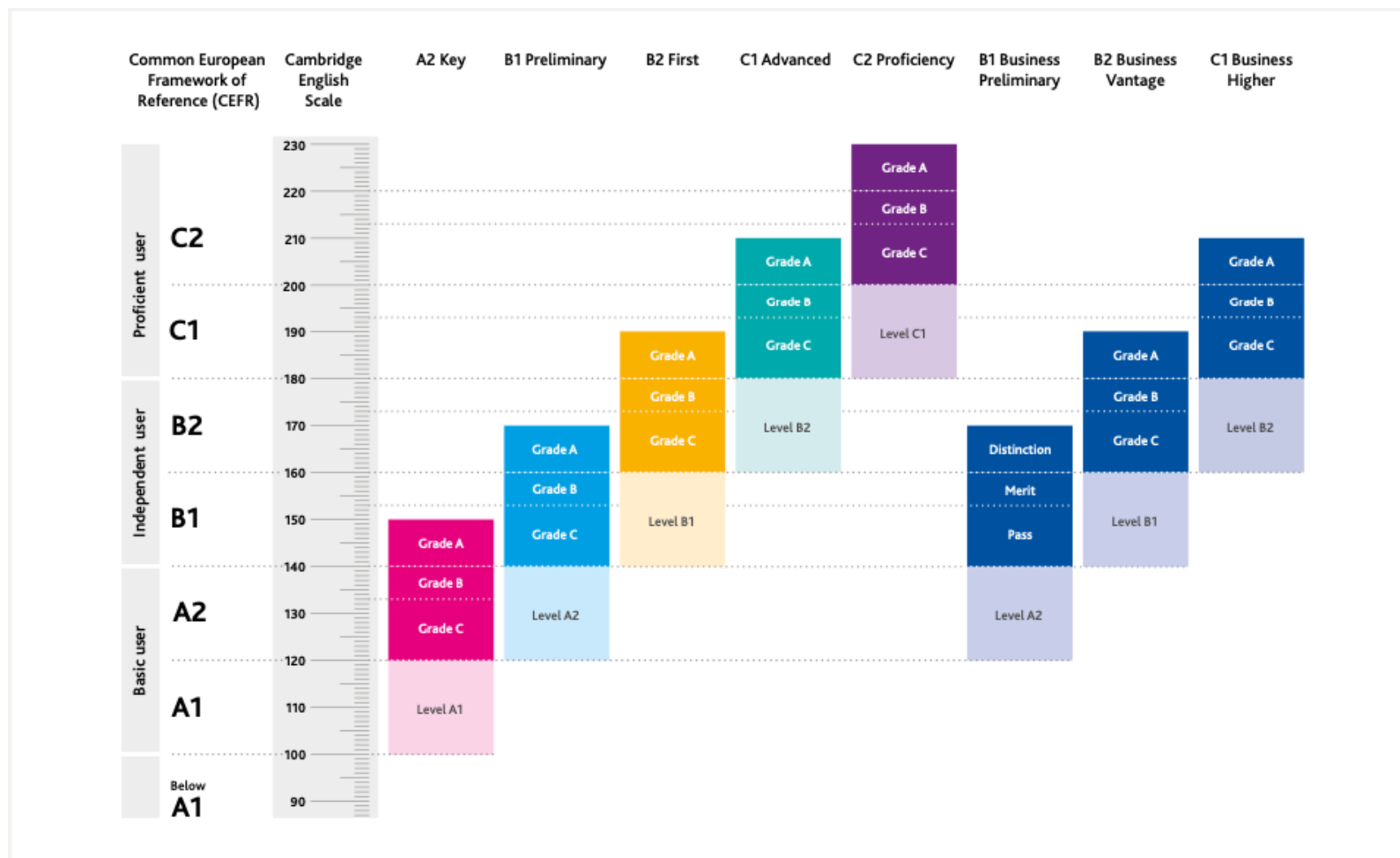

/ Level B2 and C1

- * B2: Achieving a certificate at this upper-intermediate proves that a candidate is becoming **skilled** in English and now has **practical language skills** for **everyday written** and **spoken situations**
- * C1: Achieving a certificate at this level proves that a candidate has reached a **very advanced level** of English required in **demanding academic** and **professional settings**.

- * C1 essay: 3 ideas, choose 2, use opinions
- * B2: 140-190 words, C1 220-260 words
- * B2: 80 minutes, C1 90 minutes

- * C1 Multiple matching most important task
- * B2 Multiple matching 1 set of 5 questions
- * C1 Multiple matching 2 sets of 5 questions

/ Speaking

Format largely the same but

- * B2 Long turn: compare 2 pictures; 1 question
- * C1 Long turn: choose 2 out of 3 pictures; 2 questions
- * C1 discussion task is 1 minute longer
